

I See You!

Kids will make a tasty snack to remind them how Jesus helped a blind man see.

Snack Supplies

Each participant will need:

- 2 round orange slices
- 2 banana slices
- 2 spoonfuls of coconut
- 1 paper plate

Each Snack Service Crew will need:

- 2 plastic knives
- 2 plastic spoons



Preparation

Before crews arrive to prepare the snacks, slice the oranges and set out the rest of the ingredients and supplies. Make a sample “I See You!” snack.

Making the Snacks

Say: **Today we’re learning that Jesus gives us the power to help others! “Aha!” You guys are the first ones to put this Bible Point into action today. You are helping others by preparing a snack for them!**

Jesus had the power to do many miracles that helped people. Jesus could do miracles because Jesus is God’s Son! In today’s Bible story, we learn that Jesus helped a blind man see. Hold up a completed example of the snack. **We’re making “I See You!” snacks to help us remember the Bible story and know that Jesus gives us the power to help others! “Aha!”** Briefly tell kids how they will prepare the snack—assembly-line style.



Have children clean their hands thoroughly both before and after making snacks.

1. Eye Experts

Place two orange slices on paper plates.

2. Pupil Preparers

Use a plastic knife to slice bananas.

3. Pupil Placers

Place a banana slice on each orange slice.

4. Eyelash Layers

Place a spoonful of coconut above each eye.

During Snack Time

When Lab Crews arrive to eat, have them sit on the floor until everyone arrives. Introduce the Snack Service Crew for the day to the entire VBS. Have all the Coaches lead everyone in cheering for them.

Invite a pre-selected Snack Service Crew member to explain the snack and how it teaches the Bible story and Bible Point—Jesus helped a blind man see.
