# Live Forever

Kids will make a tasty snack to remind them that Jesus gives us the power to live forever!

### **Snack Supplies**

#### Each participant will need:

- 1 flour tortilla
- about 2 tablespoons fruit-flavored cream cheese
- 1 paper plate

#### **Each Snack Service Crew** will need:

several plastic knives



## **Preparation**

Set out the ingredients and supplies. Make a sample "Live Forever" snack.

## Making the Snacks

Say: Let's make a snack to remind us that Jesus gives us the power to live forever. "The" Jesus took our sins with him to the cross. Because Jesus died and came back to life, we can live forever with him. Show kids a pre-made "Live Forever" snack. When Jesus died, his friends wrapped him in a cloth and laid him in a tomb—which was an empty cave. When Jesus came back to life, his friends found an empty cave as well as an empty cloth. Jesus wasn't there anymore. Jesus was alive! Briefly go over the steps to prepare the snacks assembly-line style.



Have children clean their hands thoroughly both before and after making snacks.

- 1. Cloth Preparers
  - Place a tortilla on a paper plate.
- 2. Cream Cheese Spreaders Spread cream cheese on each tortilla.
- 3. Cloth Rollers Roll up each tortilla.

## **During Snack Time**

When Lab Crews arrive to eat, have them sit on the floor until everyone arrives. Introduce the Snack Service Crew for the day to the entire VBS. Have all the Coaches lead everyone in cheering for them.

Invite a pre-selected Snack Service Crew member to explain the snack and how it teaches the Bible story and Bible Point—when Jesus came back to life, he left an empty cloth in an empty tomb!
