Fiery Faith Mix

Kids will make a snack to remind them that Jesus gives us the power to tell others about God, just as he did for the believers at Pentecost.

Snack Supplies

Each participant will need:

- ¼ cup Craisins®
- ¼ cup dried apricots
- ¼ cup colored Goldfish® crackers
- ¼ cup Chex® cereal
- 1 sandwich-size baggie[®]

Each Snack Service Crew will need:

- 1 large bowl
- 4 1-cup measuring cups
- 1 large spoon
- 1 6-ounce cup

Making the Snacks

Say: Today we're learning that Jesus gives us the power to tell others about God. "When God sent the Holy Spirit to the Christians in our Bible story, it looked like tongues of fire rested on each one of them! Show kids a pre-made "Fiery Faith Mix" snack. Let's make a snack to remind us of the fiery flames in the Bible story. Briefly go over the steps to prepare the snacks—assembly-line style.

1. Ingredient Pourers

Pour 1 cup of each ingredient into a large bowl. (Let each crew member add a different ingredient.)

2. Stirrers

Stir all ingredients together.

3. Snack Scoopers

Use the 6-ounce cup to scoop up the mix and pour it into a baggie.

4. Baggie Sealers

Seal each baggie.



Preparation

Set out the ingredients and supplies. Make a sample "Fiery Faith Mix" snack.



Have children clean their hands thoroughly both before and after making snacks.

During Snack Time

When Lab Crews arrive to eat, have them sit on the floor until everyone arrives. Introduce the Snack Service Crew for the day to the entire VBS. Have all the Coaches lead everyone in cheering for them.

Invite a pre-selected Snack Service Crew member to explain the snack and how it teaches the Bible story and Bible Point—the colorful mixture reminds us of the fiery flames at Pentecost.
